CLUB REDEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Progress on the club's Stage 1 redevelopment has focused on the finalisation of draft construction and technical plans and details prepared by Fisher Architects. This has involved a review by club members with relevant expertise and interest in particular aspects of the draft proposals including the provision of electrical and hydraulic services, key requirements of the first aid room, and the general design and fit-out of the patrol room.

The drawings are now being finalised by Fisher Architects to incorporate review feedback. Once complete, the drawings will be issued to Brad Tolhurst Engineering to ensure full coordination of engineering details. The club will then be in a position to seek a Construction Certificate through Ross Bryant, building certifier, and to procure quotes for construction.


VALE BILL JACKSON
